Carla Pastore will be pursuing new endeavors as she retires from the Executive Director position here at Center for the Creative Arts. Carla provided leadership to CCArts for 11 years, helping the organization through two challenging financial periods in 2006 and 2014. During her tenure at CCArts, she built an outstanding Board and worked hard to provide a solid foundation for future growth. Working part time, she also attended West Chester University and received a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts with a minor in Art History.

- Carla developed and chaired the Luck of the Draw fundraiser and art auction for 7 years, raising over \$65,000 for scholarships for children to attend summer camp at CCArts.
- The building and grounds of CCArts were transformed by her work with garden clubs and local businesses to landscape and maintain the property and add an outdoor sculpture garden.
- Over a four year period she wrote grants which resulted in over \$380,000 for general operating and building improvements including roof replacement, HVAC units, pumps and battery backup systems, exterior doors, smoke detectors and floor replacement.
- She hung all CCArts Members and Regional Art Shows and had a special interest in creating beautiful floral arrangements for each event.

Carla was a champion for the organization always engaging her friends, family and colleagues in the activities of the Center. She was passionate about the arts, committing all her talents, energy and resources to the Center.

We thank Carla immensely for her time as Executive Director and wish her all the best with any future endeavors!
